

## **Occupational Health Advisor**

### **Job Purpose**

The post holder will be responsible for delivering a high quality, consistent and professional occupational health service.

The successful applicant will report to the Senior Occupational Health Advisor with a dotted line responsibility to the EHS Manager.

Responsibilities include:

- All Health Surveillance as identified by risk assessment such as: Audiometry, Spirometry, Vision, FLT driver Medicals, Hot Worker Medicals, Night Worker Medicals
- Travel medicine including travel vaccinations
- Well Person Screening
- Case Management
- Health Promotion
- Sickness Absence Management
- Pre-Employment Medicals to include drug testing
- Support to Mental Health First Aiders
- Attendance as EHS committee meetings

In addition, the job holder will be responsible for maintaining electronic OH data; providing statistics and carrying out specific project work as requested by the HR or EHS Managers.

### **Personal Attributes/Skills/Experience**

You will be a Registered General Nurse with an active PIN with no restrictions or conditions and hold an Occupational Health qualification. You will have recent experience of the full Occupational Health remit preferably within manufacturing. Case management experience is essential.
